

CONSTITUTION, CIVIL LIBERTIES, AND FOUNDING PRINCIPLES BOARD GAME PROJECT (60 POINTS)--STRAHN

Assignment: You (and a team of up to three others) will create an engaging and educationally accurate board game about the U.S. Constitution and America’s Founding Principles. The game’s purpose is to address required content contained on the Constitution Test Study Guide in an enjoyable, creative, and original format that will help students review for our Constitution Test Assessment on Monday, March 11, 2019. All board games must include the following:

- **The Names of all Group Members (on back)**
- **A Game Title**
- **An Original Game Board and Game Pieces**
- **Clear Rules and Typed Instructions for Play (1 page or less)**
- **A Minimum of 21 Info Cards/Questions (7 Easy, 7 Moderate, and 7 Difficult) Based on Strahn’s Constitution Test Study Guide**

Content/Accuracy:

Content is useful and provides an accurate, engaging, and helpful review of required content for the Constitution Test based on Strahn's Study Guide; Game contains a title, game board, game pieces, and a minimum of 21 info cards/questions (7 easy, 7 moderate, and 7 difficult) which are directly related to the Constitution Test Study Guide and are somehow incorporated into the game.

Game Design:

Game concept and design is engaging, thoughtful, creative, and original (i.e. not simply a copy of Candyland, or some other well-known game); Difficulty is appropriate for classmates; Game is fun to play.
